2. A 100 to 200 word narrative in your own handwriting expressing your reasons and needs for applying for this scholarship.
3. Results of college entrance exams (i.e., ACT or CEED-SAT scores).
4. Complete transcript of grades from the most recent grading session.
5. A letter from a member of your school's teaching staff that attests to your qualifications as they observed your academic and extra-curricular performance. This letter must be requested by the applicant and sent with the application in a sealed envelope initialed across the flap by the staff member.
6. At least two other letters of recommendation from persons, other than relatives, that attest to your character and potential. These letters should be included with your application.
7. A copy of the acceptance letter from the college or university to be attended.
8. Billfold size picture of scholarship applicant.
9. Copy of the DD 214, discharge papers, or proof of eligibility of the descendant to the veteran.
10. Package must be received at American Legion Post 237, or it may be mailed to: American Legion Post 237, Attn: Wargo Scholarship, PO Box 1176, Huntsville, AL 35807, no later than April 30th. Applications received after this date will not be considered by the committee.
